

This is a one-year, full-time Top-up programme designed for international students with an English language, communication or translation-related HND or associate degree (or equivalent). The programme enables students to adjust to studying in the UK and gain a full honours degree, with the skills and knowledge required for further postgraduate study.

On successful completion, students will be awarded a BA (Hons) in Business English (International Route) and will be able to apply to UK universities for a business postgraduate degree. Students achieving a 2nd class honours (2:2) will be guaranteed entry to the University of Chichester MSc International Business programmes, with bursaries available for students achieving a 2:1 or above.



The business english project is designed to prepare students for the demands of a postgraduate dissertation. It includes a taught introduction to business and language research with independent research work.



Entry requirements:

 This programme is designed specifically for international students with an overseas HND/associate degree. Applicants should normally have an HND (Grade C or Pass,) or associate degree (or equivalent) at 65% from a recognised institution in the area of English language, Communications or Translation (including English).

English requirements:

- Minimum IELTS 5.5 with no component below 5.5*
- * Pre-sessional English language programme available from IELTS 4.5 (10 weeks: July and August) or 5.0 (5 weeks: August)

Fees:

Pre-sessional:

- £2,400 for the 10 week programme
- £1,200 for the 5 week programme
